



## ACADEMIR DUAL ENROLLMENT SCHOLARS PROGRAM

The AcadeMir Dual Scholars Program offers the students an opportunity to challenge themselves and excel academically. The students will be able to be promoted from middle school to high school with high school credits and college credits at the same time. Students that start the program as of 6<sup>th</sup> grade will be able to complete up to 13 college credits.

Students that are interested in participating in the program must have:

- A high school grade point average of 3.0 by the end of 6<sup>th</sup> grade.
- Pass the FSA Reading and FSA Math assessments with a 3 or higher
- Take and pass the PERT exam (college placement exam)
- Maintain class averages of A's and B's within all academic core classes.

The Scholars' schedule will consist of four academic core classes, three electives and two college courses which are semesterized. Scholars are encouraged to earn A's and B's in all college courses in order to improve their success with college admission

Below is an example of the schedule for a student starting the program as of 6<sup>th</sup> grade:
